

# **Frequently Asked Questions Corporate Sponsorships**

## What are the benefits of becoming a Jekyll Island Foundation Corporate Sponsor?

Sponsorship privileges include website and social media acknowledgements, annual island parking and guest amenity passes, and events.

#### Is sponsorship tax deductible?

The tax-deductible amount of your corporate sponsorship is limited to the excess of money contributed over the fair market value (FMV) of benefits provided. Sponsors receive a yearend tax statement listing the FMV of benefits received.

#### How do I receive my benefits as a corporate sponsor?

Once contracting is complete, Sponsor will receive a document detailing how to access all benefits associated with sponsorship.

## How do I activate parking passes?

Parking passes are managed by the Jekyll Island Foundation. To activate, simply complete and return the Vehicle Information Sheet in the sponsor packet or email the following information to for each vehicle: make, model, color, and state/tag number.

# What are amenity passes and what do they include?

Each pass is valid for a single admission to one of the following amenities and must be presented and relinquished at time of use: Georgia Sea Turtle Center, Historic Tours, Mosaic Museum, Golf, Mini Golf, Tennis, and Summer Waves.
